

April 8, 1954

Regular meeting of the Town Board was held in the Town Garage.
Supv. Christman called the meeting to order at 8:00 P.M.

Present were:

Also present were a group of resident tax payers, and the Town Health Officer
Dr. Walker.

Clerk read the minutes fo the previous meeting and added the correction of
Mariaville Civic Association, instead of Civic League.

Motion by Justice Jones and seconded by Justice Wolfe that the minutes be
accepted as read and corrected.
Motion carried.

Supv. Christman then opened the meeting under Public Hearing.

Mr. Swart was the first to be heard, and stated that, if the Town Board was
in favor of the adoption of the Health Ordinance presented, that the Mariaville
Civic Association would stand the expence of policing at Mariaville Lake.

Mr. Robert Bender of Duane Lake was next to be heard, and stated he was in favor
of the Ordinance, but did not know about contributing to the expence of
policing the area.

Mr. Swart then said he would go on record for the Mariaville Civic Association
saying that they would make arrangements for policing at Duane Lake also.

Mr. Bender then stated he was very much in favor of the Ordinance, and re-
quested the Board to adopt the Ordinance.

Clerk as then instructed to Publish Ordinance and Notice of Public Hearing
to appear in the Town's official News Paper. The Hearing to be held
April 26, 1954 at 7:30 P.M. in the Mariaville Fire Hall, Mariaville, N.Y.

Mr. Swart thanked the Board for the signs erected on South Lake Road.

Next Dr. Walker, Health Officer, gave his report on further inspections at the
Rendinger Plant, and stated that the situation had not been corrected as to
the dumping of raw entrails in the open field, and stated that he believed
some legal action would have to be taken.

Mr. Robert Shaffer then asked to speak, and said the Town Board should look
into Zoning Plan for the Town to protect the Towns people against undesirable
situations occuring in the future.

Supv. Christman then asked if there was anyone else who wished to say anything,
and since there was no one else, the meeting was closed under Public Hearing
and opened under Regular Business.

Officers reports were next read, and it was moved by Justice McDougall and
seconded by Justice Wolfe the the reports be accepted as read.
