The following is a report of my work as town historian for the year 1955 just closed:

1. I made 28 personal calls on individuals at their homes.
2. I made clippings of all historical news and events of interest to the Town of Duanesburg and the neighboring towns.
3. Wherever possible, I attended historical meetings held within the town and Schenectady.
4. I answered 45 inquiries, some by phone, but mostly by letter regarding Duanesburg data, including cemetery inscriptions, family history, etc. These inquiries came from as far west as California and as far south as Florida.
5. I finished cleaning up the Eaton's Corners Cemetery on the McIntosh farm.
6. I did some research on Fraternal organizations within the town.
7. I aided in placing flags on soldiers and sailors graves for Memorial Day.
