PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT THE TOWN Board of the Town of Duaneburg, County of Schenectady, and State of New York, will hold a public hearing in said Township on the 11th day of June, 1953 at 8:00 o'clock P. M. Eastern Daylight Saving Time, at the Town Garage of said Town in a public Ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF ANY LANDS WITHIN THE TOWN OF DUANEBURG AS A DUMP AND/OR DUMPING GROUNDS

The Town Board of the Town of Duaneburg, pursuant to the provisions of Subdivision 6 of Sect. 20 of the Town Law, ordains as follows:

Section 1. Definitions. The term rubbish as used in this ordinance shall include waste metal, tin cans, ashes, cinders, glass, pottery and other substances of a solid and incandescent nature. The term garbage as used in this ordinance shall include waste food, papers, dead animals or parts thereof, and all waste or discarded wood or lumber or vegetable matter of any kind or any other matter which shall be inflammable or capable of fermentation or decay.

Section 2. No person, person, firm, society, firm, corporation or other enterprise shall throw, deposit, dump or otherwise dispose of any garbage, rubbish, dirt, debris, refuse, and/or abandoned vehicles or parts thereof in or upon any land or upon any road, street or highway or within the Township of Duaneburg except as hereinafter provided.

Section 3. Any person or persons being an owner of or a tenant lawfully in possession and occupancy of real property located in the Town of Duaneburg may use his property for the disposal of garbage and rubbish which has accumulated from and is incidental to a domestic and/or semi-commercial use of said property or a business operated by such person or persons.

This Ordinance excepts from its provisions any Incorporated Village or Village within the Township, or any dump or disposal for trash, refuse, garbage and waste for which a permit has been granted by the Board of Health, and/or the Town Board of the Town of Duaneburg.

Section 4. Penalties. Any person or persons violating any provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof be punishable by a fine not exceeding (\$90.00) or imprisonment of 90 days, or both fine and imprisonment or both. This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after the publication and posting thereof pursuant to law, at which time and place all persons interested will be heard.

Eastern Daylight Savings Time, at the Town Garage of said Town on a proposal of the enactment of the following Ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF ANY LANDS WITHIN THE TOWN OF DUANESBURG AS A DUMP AND/OR DUMPING GROUNDS.

The Town Board of the Town of Duaneburg, pursuant to the provisions of Subdivision 6 of Sect. 130 of the Town Law, ordains as follows:

Section 1. Definitions. The term rubbish as used in this ordinance shall include was metal, tin cans, ashes, cinders, glass, pottery and all discarded substances of a solid and incombustible nature. The term garbage as used in this ordinance shall include waste food, papers, dead animals or parts thereof, and all waste or discarded wood or lumber or vegetable matter of any kind or any other matter which shall be inflammable or capable of fermentation or decay.

Section 2. No person, persons, club, society, firm, corporation or otherwise, shall throw, deposit, dump or abandon any garbage, rubbish, dirt, debris, refuse, and/or abandoned vehicles or parts thereof in or upon any land or lands, either public or private, or upon any road, street or thoroughfare within the Township or Duaneburg except as hereinafter provided.

Exception 3. Any person or persons being an owner of or, a tenant lawfully in possession and occupancy of real property located in the Town of Duaneburg may use his property for the disposal of garbage and rubbish which has accumulated from and is incidental to a domestic and/or agricultural use of said property, or a business operated by such person or persons.

This Ordinance excepts from its provisions any incorporated Village or Villages, within the Township, or any dump or disposal for trash, refuse, garbage and waste for which a permit has been granted by the Board of Health, and/or the Town Board of the Town of Duaneburg.

Section 4. Penalties. Any person or persons violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof be punishable by a fine not exceeding (\$50.00) or imprisonment, or by both fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after the publication and posting thereof pursuant to law, at which time and place all persons interested will be heard.
