Public Hearing held May 21st 1948 in Gibson School house, school district 10, Town of Duanesburg. Meeting called to order by the Supervisor at 8:15 P.M.

The clerk read the call of the Public Hearing.
There were 12 people present.

Next the clerk read the boundaries of the proposed fire protection and same were pointed out on a map by the Supervisor.

After a general discussion the question was finally put to a vote and all present were in favor of establishing said fire protection district, no one opposed same.

As a result of above vote it was:

Moved by Justice Jones, seconded by Justice Tullock, that

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Duanesburg, Schenectady Co., New York, on its own motion and without a written petition, but following a request for such action, proposes the establishment of a fire protection district to embrace the territory hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, a notice in due form, containing a description of the proposed fire protection district, and specifying the time when and the place where the Town Board would meet to consider the establishment of said district and hear all persons interested in the subject concerning the same, was duly published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such notice, a public hearing was duly held by said Town Board of the Town of Duanesburg on the 21st day of May 1948 commencing at 8 P.M., in the Gibson School house of school district #10, Town of Duanesburg, being within the limits of the proposed district, and

WHEREAS, all persons interested who desired to be heard, were duly heard and all due deliberation having been had, NOW, upon the evidence given at such Public Hearing and on the motion of Justice Jones, seconded by Justice Tullock, it is hereby

RESOLVED, pursuant to Art., # 11 of the Town Law of the State of New York, that it is hereby determined that it is in the public interest to establish said Fire Protection district; and that it is in such interest that there is hereby established a fire protection district within the Town of Duanesburg, Schenectady County, N.Y., to be known as Fire Protection District # 3, to be contained in and embrace the following boundaries;

Beginning at the point of intersection of the center lines of the Cole road and route # 7 (SH-1029), thence in an easterly direction (SH-1029) for a distance of 1032 feet to a point of intersection of said highway and the dividing line between Election district #3 and # 4, thence northwesterly along said dividing line to the point of intersection of the center lines of Route # 20 (SH-1454) and the Knight road, Pt.1, (CR26-D0), thence in a northerly direction along said road and over Pt. 2 of said road to the intersection of the center lines of said Knight road and the Highland Park road, thence northwesterly on a straight line, east of the home of Allen, to a point in the northerly boundary of the Town of Duanesburg, said point being 1640 feet east of the center line of the Millers Cors., road, (CR-19D), along the northerly boundary of the Town of Duanesburg, thence in a southwesterly direction, and continuing along

the western and southern boundaries of the Town of Duanesburg to a point where said southern boundary intersects the west boundary of Quaker Street Fire Dist., # 1, thence in a northerly and easterly direction along the boundary of Quaker Street Fire Dist., 1 to the southwest corner of the boundary of the Incorporated Village of Delanson, thence following the west, north and easterly boundary of the Village of Delanson to its intersection with the northerly boundary of the Quaker Street Fire Dist., # 1, thence northeasterly along said bounds of Quaker Street Fire Dist., # 1, in a straight line to a point in the center line of the Cole road, said point being 1220 feet north of the intersection of the center line of said Cole road on route # 7 (SH-1029), thence southerly along Cole road to the point of Beginning.

RESOLVED, that this Board does hereby find and determine that all the property, property owners and interested persons within the district, are benefited thereby, and that all property or property owners benefited are included therein.
