also present were a group of business men from the Hamlet of Duaneburg Mr. Schrade welcomed the group to the meeting.

Supervisor Schrade opened the meeting under Public Hearing. Mr. Reardon then introduced himself as the owner of the Hub restaurant in Duaneburg, and wished to comment on the new order issued by the State Traffic Commission in regards to Prohibiting Diagonal Parking in Duaneburg.

Mr. Reardon stated that the order would hurt the business men and the community as well.

Mr. Sherwin Schrade, and Mr. Pavlic, also business men in Duaneburg agreed with Mr. Reardon, and suggested the Town Board take action against the order.

After a discussion was held the following resolution was offered and moved by Justice McDougall, seconded by Justice Garry,

Resolved: that the Town Board of the Town of Duaneburg objects to the order by the State Traffic Commission prohibiting diagonal parking in the Hamlet of Duaneburg, as follows,

1. Prohibits the diagonal parking of vehicles in the Hamlet of Duaneburg, Town of Duaneburg, Schenectady County, as follows:
A. On the south side of route 20 between station 262-47 on S.H. 8097, and station 446-93 on S.H. 5551, a distance of 147 feet.

- B. On the north side of route 7 between station 445-14 on S.H. 5545 and Station 446-50 on S.H. 5551, a distance of 51 feet.

The Board feels that if the Commission would re-install the four signal lights which were removed, it would remedy the hazardous condition which the Commission feels now exists.

The Town still has in their possession the four original lights which were removed.
