

RESOLUTION BY THE TOWN BOARD OF DUANESBURG
SCHENECTADY COUNTY

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2 of 12/8/77 meeting.

WHEREAS, in connection with the construction of Interstate Route 508, I-88, Susquehanna Expressway, Schenectady County, and under the provisions of Subdivision 25 of Section 10 of the New York Highway Law as amended, which provides in part, that the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation shall "Have power to combine, connect, alter, relocate, terminate and pave intersecting highways, roads or streets" and, also, that the maintenance of any highway, road or street which is affected by this subdivision and which, in the judgement of the Commissioner, is not deemed to be a part of the State Highway system, shall be maintained by the municipality or the municipalities in which roads are located, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner proposes to construct Interstate Route 508, I-88, Susquehanna Expressway, Schenectady County, and in connection therewith to reconstruct Featherstonhaugh Road between centerline stations F10+00 and F32+57, to terminate Featherstonhaugh Road 200'+ north of station 467+00, and to remove and destroy the Depot Road between the south edge of Route 7 and the south right-of-way line of I-88, and

WHEREAS, said highways, roads or streets are to be located within the Town of Duanesburg and in the judgement of the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation will not be deemed to be part of the State Highway system,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Duanesburg Town Board approves the above-described resurfacing, relocation, termination and reconstruction, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, upon completion of construction of the above described relocation, termination and reconstruction, the Town of Duanesburg will maintain such roads in accordance with the provisions of the Highway Law.

This resolution was passed by the Town Board of the town of Duanesburg on 12/8/77.
