In 1942 Francis Wilson volunteered for services in the United States Army. In June 1944 on D-Day Francis Wilson parachuted out of a C-47 over Normandy where he was shot in the back. In August of 1944 Francis Wilson received a Purple Heart and Silver Star that was awarded for his Gallantry in Grave, Holland. He was later discharged as a Staff Sergeant.
