# RESOLUTION OF TOWN BOARD FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF A FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Duanesburg, Schoenectady Co. New York, on its own motion and without a written petition, but following a request for such action, proposes the establishment of a Fire Protection District to embrace the territory hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, a notice in due form, containing a description of the proposed Fire Protection District, and specifying the time when and the place where the Town Board would meet to consider the establishment of said District and where all persons interested in the subject concerning the same, was duly published and posted as required by law, and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to such notice a Public Hearing was duly held by said Town Board of the Town of Duanesburg, on the 21st day of May 1948, commencing at 8 P.M. DST, at the Gibson school house, school district # 10, in the Town of Duanesburg, Schoenectady Co. New York, being within the limits of the proposed Fire Protection District, and

WHEREAS, all persons interested in, who desired to be heard, were duly heard, and due deliberation having been had, NOW, upon the evidence given at such Public Hearing and on motion of Justice Jones, seconded by Justice Tullock, it is hereby:

RESOLVED, pursuant to Article 11 of the Town Law of the State of New York, that it is hereby determined that it is in the Public interest to establish said Fire Protection District; and that it is in such interest that there is hereby established a Fire Protection District within the Town of Duanesburg, Schoenectady Co., New York, to be known as Fire Protection District # 3, to be contained in and embrace the following boundaries; beginning at the point of intersection of the center lines of the Cole Road and route # 7 (SH-1029), thence in an Easterly direction for a distance of 1032 feet to the point of intersection of said highway and the dividing line between Election Districts #3 & #4, thence Northwesterly along said dividing line to the point of intersection of the center lines of route # 20 (SH-1454) and the Knight road, P (CR-26-D), thence in a Northerly direction along said road and a portion of said road to the intersection of the center lines of said Knight road and the Highland Park road connection (Town Road) thence Northwesterly on a straight line, East of the home of Al to a point in the Northerly boundary of the Town of Duanesburg, said point being 1640 feet East of the center line of the Miller Corners road (CR-19-D) along the Northerly boundary of the Town of Duanesburg; thence in a Southwesterly direction, and continuing along the Western and Southern boundaries of the Town of Duanesburg, to a point where said Southern boundary intersects the Western boundary of Quaker Street Fire Dist., # 1; thence in a Northerly and Easterly direction along the boundary of Quaker Street Fire Dist., # 1, to the Southwest corner of the boundary of the Inc., Village of Delanson, thence following the West, North and Eastern boundary of the Village of Delanson, Inc.; to its intersection with the Northerly boundary of the Quaker Street Fire District; thence Northeasterly along said boundary of Quaker Street Fire Dist., # 1, in a straight line to a point in the center line of Cole Road, said point being 1220 feet North of the intersection of the center line of said Cole road on route # 7 (SH-1029) thence Southerly along Cole road to the point of beginning.

RESOLVED, that this Board does hereby find and determine that the property, property owners and interested persons within the district are benefited thereby, and that all property or property owners benefited are included therein.

Upon the question of adoption of the foregoing resolution the following each voted "Aye" in favor of said resolution;

None voted "no" in opposition to said resolution.

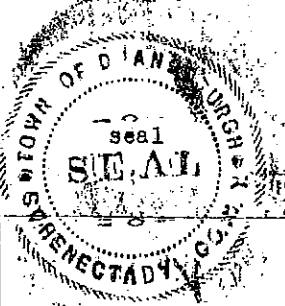
The resolution, having received at least a two-thirds vote of the members of the Town Board, was declared by the Supervisor to be duly adopted.
