RESOLUTION OF TOWN BOARD FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF A FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Duanesburg, Schenectedy C_{ℓ} New York, on its own motion and without a written petition, but following a request for such action, proposes the establishment (a Fire Protection District to embrace the territory hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, a notice in due form, containing a description of the proposed Fire Protection District, and specifying the time when and the place where the Town Board would meet to consider the

and the place where the Town Board would meet to consider the establishment of said District and where all persons interested in the subject concerning the same, was duly published and poste as required by law, and the such notice a Public Hearing was duly held by said Town Board of the Town of Duanesburg, on the 21st day of May 1948, commencing at 8 P.M. DST, at the Gibson school house, school district # 10, in the Town of Duanesburg, Schenectady Co. New York, being within the limits of the proposed Fire Protection District, and

WHEREAS, all persons interested in, who desired to be heard, wer duly heard, and due deliberation having been had, NOW, upon the evidence given at such Public Hearing and on motion of Justice Jones, seconded by Justice Tullock, it is hereby:

RESOLVED, pursuant to Article 11 of the Town Law of the State of New York, that it is hereby determined that it is in the Public interest to establish said Fire Protection District; and that it is in such interest that there is hereby established a Fire Prot ection District within the Town of Duenesburg, Schenectady Co., New York, to be known as Fire Protection District # 3, to be co tained in and embrace the following boundaries; beginning at the point of intersection of the center lines of the Cole Road and route # 7 (SH-1029), thence in an Easterly direction for a district of 1032 feet to the point of intersection of said highway and to dividing line between Election Districts #3 & #4, thence North-westerly along said dividing line to the point of intersection (the center lines of route # 20 (SH-1454) and the Knight road, P (CR-26-D), thence in a Northerly direction along said road and Pt.2 of said road to the intersection of the center lines of sa Knight road and the Highland Park road connection (Town Road) thence Northwesterly on a straight line, East of the home of Al to a point in the Northerly boundary of the Town of Dusnesburg, said point being 1640 feet East of the center line of the Mills Corners road (CR-19-D) along the Northerly boundary of the Town Duenesburg; thence in a Southwesterly direction, and continuing along the Western and Southern boundaries of the Town of Duenes along the Western and Southern boundaries of the Town of Duanes burg, to a point where said Southern boundary intersects the We boundary of Cuaker Street Fire Dist., # 1; thence in a Northerl and Easterly direction along the boundary of Guaker Street Fire Dist., #1; to the Southwest corner of the boundary of the Inc., Dist., #1; to the Southwest corner of the boundary of the Inc., Village of Delenson, thence following the West, North and Easte boundary of the Village of Delenson, Inc., to its intersection with the Northerly boundary of the Guaker Street Fire District thence Northeasterly along said bounds of Guaker Street Fire District will in a straight line to a point in the center line of Gole is said point being 1220 feet North of the intersection of the center line of said Cole road on route # 7 (SR-1029) thence Southerly along Cole road to the point of beginning. along Cole road to the point of beginning.
