## LOCAL LAW # 1 OF THE YEAR 1985

A local law in relation to alternative Veteran's Exemption from Real Property Taxation.

A local law in relation to alternative veteran's exemption from real property taxation.

SECTION 1: The purpose of this law is to reduce the maximum veteran's exemption allowable pursuant to Section 458-A of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 2: Pursuant to the provisions of subdivision 2 (d) of Section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, the maximum veteran's exemption from real property taxes allowable pursuant to Section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law is established as follows for the Town of Duaneburg:

- a. Qualifying residential real property shall be exempt from taxation to the extent of fifteen percent of the assessed value of such property; provided, however, that such exemption shall not exceed the lesser of six thousand dollars or the product of six thousand dollars multiplied by the latest state equalization rate for the Town of Duaneburg.
- b. In addition to the exemption provided by paragraph (a) of this subdivision, where the veteran served in a combat theatre or combat zone of operations, as documented by the award of a United States campaign ribbon or service medal, qualifying residential real property shall also be exempt from taxation to the extent of ten percent of the assessed value of such property; provided, however, that such exemption shall not exceed the lesser of four thousand dollars or the product of four thousand dollars multiplied by the latest state equalization rate for the Town of Duaneburg.
- c. In addition to the exemptions provided by paragraphs (a) and (b) of this subdivision, where the veteran received a compensation rating from the United States Veteran's administration because of a service connected disability, qualifying residential real property shall be exempt from taxation to the extent of the product of the assessed value of such property multiplied by fifty percent of the veteran's disability rating; provided, however, that such exemption shall not exceed the lesser of twenty thousand dollars or the product of twenty thousand dollars multiplied by the latest state equalization rate for the Town of Duaneburg.

SECTION 3: This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State and the State Comptroller as required by Section 103 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.
