- SECTION 5. All burning shall be controlled so smoke and fumes do not interfere with the quality of life of neighbors.
- SECTION 6. Violations. Any violations of this law, except as hereinafter provided, is hereby declared to be an offense and shall be punishable by a fine of not less than (twenty-five) \$25.00 nor more than (two-hundred fifty) \$250.00 or by imprisonment for a term not to exceed (thirty) 30 days or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- SECTION 7. Interpretation. The provisions of this law shall be deemed minimal requirements for promotion of the public safety. Wherever the requirements of this law vary with the requirement of any other lawfully adopted rule, ordinance, regulation or resolution, the most restrictive, or those requiremposing the higher standards, shall govern.
- SECTION 8. Validity. If any section, paragraph, clause, phrase or other provision of this law shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this law as a whole or any part or provision thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.
- SECTION 9. Effective date. This law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State of New York.
- SECTION 10. This law shall not apply to burning done on land actively used for agricultural purposes.
