July 14, 1960

Special meeting of the Town Board was held in the Town Garage. Supervisor Nott called the meeting to order at 7:30 P.M. Clerk called the roll; Justice Jones Present

Special meeting held for the purpose of holding a hearing on the adoption of a Bingo Ordinance.

The following persons were present, Kenneth Groat, Mr. Lamb, Mr. Fred Skinner, Mr. George Yarn, and Mr. C. Mericle.

Clerk read the public Notice, and Ordinance.

Supervisor asked if anyone wished to be heard in favor or against the ordinance as read, As no wished to speak against the ordinance Supervisor declared the public hearing closed, and opened the meeting under regular meeting.

Clerk read minutes of last meeting, minutes approved as read.

Bills were presented for audit.

Motion by Councilman Ash, seconded by Justice Jones the bills be paid as audited.

Adopted by roll call of 5 ayes.

Clerk read letter from Rockwell Manufacturing Co. makers of Automatic Voting machines stating a price of \$1531.00 per machine. Clerk recommended that the Board give some thought as to purchasing a new machine each year until to replace the old machines now in use.

Councilman Maddell stated he had recieved phone calls inquiring where people could dump garbage.

The Board discussed the dumping problem of the Town of Duaneburg, and the possability of establishing a Town Dump.

Justice Knowles offered and Moved the motion, seconded by Councilman Maddell, that the Supervisor investigate the possible purchase of a piece of land for the purpose of a Town Dump not in the excess of \$1000.00

Adopted by roll call of 5 Ayes.

Councilman Maddell, offered and moved for adoption the following motion, seconded by Councilman Ash, whereas; the Town Superintendent be empowered to expend \$500.00 for the purchase of tools and equipment.

Adopted by roll call of 5 Ayes.

Councilman Maddell offered and moved for adoption the following resolution, seconded by Councilman Ash,

RESOLUTION # 17

Whereas; after a public hearing was held on the following Ordinance entitled Town of Duaneburg Bingo Ordinance, and whereas; all persons who wished to be heard were heard, now therefore be resolved that the following Ordinance entitled "Town of Duaneburg Bingo Ordinance" be duly adopted.

Adopted by roll call of 5 Ayes.

Supervisors accounts were audited and found to be correct.

Moved by Jones, seconded by Ash meeting adjourn.

O R D I N A N C E      N O .      4

Councilman Waddell offered and moved the following, seconded by Councilman Ash;

AN ORDINANCE to provide for the playing of the game of Bingo within the territorial limits of the Town of Duanesburg, County of Schenectady subject to the provisions of the State Lottery Control Law.

WHEREAS; a Constitutional Amendment has been approved, authorizing the playing of the game of Bingo within the State of New York, subject to certain conditions; and

WHEREAS the laws of the State of New York further provide that this game may be played provided such play is authorized by ordinance of the Town Board of the local municipality and further approved by a majority of the qualified electors of such municipality voting on a proposal therefor, submitted at a general or special election held within such municipality; and

WHEREAS it the desire of the Town Board to permit the people of the Town of Duanesburg to register their sentiments on whether they desire this game to be played within the Town limits of the Town of Duanesburg; Now therefore,

The Town Board of the Town of Duanesburg, in a regular meeting convened, ordains as follows;

SECTION 1. Subject to the approval by a majority of the qualified electors of the Town of Duanesburg voting on the proposal therefor, at the next general election, it shall be lawful for bona fide religious, charitable or non-profit organizations of veterans, volunteer firemen and similar non-profit organizations to conduct the game of bingo provided that the entire net proceeds of any game shall be exclusively devoted to the lawful purposes of such organizations; no single prize shall exceed two hundred and fifty dollars; no series of prizes on any one occasion shall aggregate more than one thousand dollars; no person except a bona fide member of any such organization shall participate in the management or operation of such game; and no person shall receive any remuneration for participating in the management or operation of any such game, and provided further that said authorized organization and/or organizations are duly licensed pursuant to the provisions of Article 14-G of the General Municipal Law commonly known as the "Bingo Licensing Law "

SECTION 2. Pursuant to provisions of Article 14-G, of the General Municipal Law, "Local Option for conduct of certain games of bingo by certain organizations", the unauthorised conduct of a bingo game and any lawful violation of any provision of this ordinance shall constitute and be punishable as a misdemeanor.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall not become operative or

effective unless it shall have been approved by a majority of the qualified electors of such municipality voting on a proposition therefore submitted at the next general election to be held in the Town of Duanesburg and upon publication of the ordinance in the manner prescribed Law.
