

RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF A PROPOSED ORDINANCE WHICH WOULD REGULATE THE GROSS WEIGHT LIMIT ON THE WELLS ROAD IN THE TOWN OF DUANESBURG, NEW YORK, TO FOUR (4) TONS OR EIGHT THOUSAND (8,000) POUNDS.

At a Special Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Duaneburg, Schenectady County, New York, in said Town of Duaneburg, on the 28th day of February, 1969, at 7:30 P.M., there were:

W. David Waddell, Councilman, offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, there has been a finding made, after due deliberation, that said bridge on Wells Road is unsafe for vehicles over Four Tons or Eight Thousand Pounds (8,000), said bridge expanding over the Chuckanda Creek on said Wells Road,

WHEREAS, due notice by Publication was made on the 17th day of February, 1969, in the Schenectady Gazette, of a public hearing to hear all persons both for and against such amendment, at 7:30 P.M. on said day, at the Town Hall, in the Town of Duaneburg, and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is made pursuant to Section 130 of the Town Law of the State of New York and pursuant to Section 1660 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York, now,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

That pursuant to Section 130 of the Town Law of the State of New York and pursuant to Section 1660 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York, that the gross weight limit of vehicles using the bridge over the Chuckanda Creek over the Wells Road, in the Town of Duaneburg, County of Schenectady, New York,

be, and the same is, restricted to a gross weight limit of Four Tons or Eight Thousand Pounds,

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed an offense and shall be delt with pursuant to the applicable Sections of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York which govern penalties for the violation of local ordinances adopted pursuant to said Vehicle and Traffic Law, and, not to exceed Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per offense, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption of this resolution, after public hearing at the Town Hall on Route #20, Town of Duaneburg, and after compliance with section 133 of the Town Law requiring posting and Publication.

Special Meeting

Special Meeting of the Town Board was held for the purpose of holding a Public Hearing on Weight Load limit change on the bridge on Bridge over Chuctanunda Creek on Wells Road, also on an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance under Section 5 of the Town Zoning Ordinance.

Supervisor Lawton called the meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

Clerk called the roll. Present were; Justice Jones, Justice MacDougall, Councilman Waddell, Councilman Ash, and Supervisor Lawton. There were also 33 interested residents present.

Clerk read Legal Notice of proposed Weight change on Bridge on Wells Road. *Res A 4*

Supervisor Lawton opened the meeting to the floor. After some discussion Councilman Waddell moved and seconded by Justice MacDougall that the Weight Limit on Bridge on Wells Road be posted Limited to *(4)* Tons. Adopted by roll call of 5 ayes.

Clerk read Legal Notice of Proposed Zoning Ordinance change under Section 5, Sub-Division 5.21, 5.23, and 5.24 relating to Lot Size.

Supervisor called on Zoning Officer Herbert Bennett to explain the change as he had outlined on the blackboard.

An open discussion was held, and Mr. Bennett answered questions from the floor.

Supervisor Lawton thanked Mr. Bennett for a splendid explanation of the proposed change, and closed the meeting to the floor.

Justice MacDougall moved and seconded by Councilman Ash that no action be taken at this meeting to give the Town Board time to evaluate the subject, and to be discussed at the next regular meeting March 13th, at which time the Public may voice their opinions again. Adopted by a roll call of 5 ayes.

Motion made by Justice MacDougall and seconded by Councilman Waddell that the meeting adjourn.
